Doubling. Competitors (including coxes) may only enter one event in the morning (AM) and one event in the afternoon (PM). Full details about doubling up of crews, coxes and boats is on BROE2. All doubling must be notified with entry.

The Regatta Committee may refuse doubled entries at time of draw.

Draw will take place on Sunday 2 June 2019 at 1pm at 1 Rushfield Road Chester CH4 7RE and will be emailed as per crew's details on BROE2 by Tuesday 4 June 2019 and posted online on www.chesterregatta.org.

Chester Regatta adheres to Row Safe the British Rowing guide to safe practice in rowing.

Competitors must produce their British Rowing membership licence in order to race and receive prizes.

The Committee's decision is final. The Committee reserves the right to declare an event or the Regatta full at any time.

A 75% refund will be offered if the Regatta is cancelled.
